ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION:

The FESA Speed Academy is initially intended for athletes of the **year of birth 2010**.

However, it is possible to fill the vacancy with athletes from the 2009 and 2008 age groups.

IMPORTANT: The National Ski Federation hereby expressly declares that the athletes participating in the FESA Speed Academy are covered by valid and adequate medical insurance, especially personal accident insurance. Please bring a copy of your insurance policy with you to the camp in case of an emergency.

Any liability of FESA is excluded.

Athletes must sign the FESA Speed Academy Declaration in advance of the event.

The camp coordinator and coaches reserve the right to send any athlete who needs to meet the necessary level for training home early.

EQUIPMENT

Athletes must bring:

- Ski equipment including at least one pair of DH /SG skis and GS skis (in case of bad weather conditions so that training is still feasible)
- Dryland training clothing
- Helmets, Goggles and Back Protector (mandatory)

All athletes must be fully equipped to participate in all training sessions.

PLEASE NOTE: The room reservation must be made independently by each NSA at Hotel Regina until February 28, 2026. The costs for the accommodation must be borne by each NSA.

Lift tickets and line fees are organized and covered by FESA after registration.
